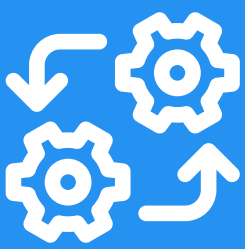




TYPES OF MANAGEMENT IN **LAW ENFORCEMENT**

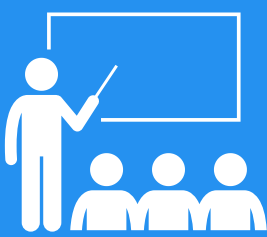
RISK MANAGEMENT
