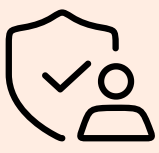




10 QUALITIES of a Great Police Leader

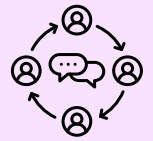


01. Integrity
